KEY TERMS

B'reisheet

The Hebrew word for Genesis. This word means *in the beginning*.

B'racha

The Hebrew word for *blessing*.

Seder

The Hebrew word for order.

Tzimtzum

A Hebrew term used to describe how God *contracted* Himself to create space for creation.

Tohu Va Vohu

The Hebrew words in Genesis 1:2 that are often translated as *formless and void*.
