#### KEY TERMS

##### B'reisheet

The Hebrew word for Genesis.  
This word means *in the beginning*.

##### B'racha

The Hebrew word for  *blessing*.

##### Seder

The Hebrew word for  *order*.

##### Tzimtzum

A Hebrew term used to describe how God *contracted* Himself to create space for creation.

##### Tohu Va Vohu

The Hebrew words in Genesis 1:2 that are often translated as *formless and void*.
